NEWS FROM RACAP

Christ the King, thank you for your donations to the RACAP Holiday Christmas Basket Program. Below is a breakdown for families, gifts, and food donations:

239 Families served

366 Adults + 266 Children = 630 total number served

RACAP provided meals for 166 families and 45 sponsors provided meals for 90 families. A total of 154 children from 64 families were provided gifts by 22 sponsors.

Cost for 2023: \$6,529.21 (2022 cost was \$2,712.00).
